**SENTENCING ORDER FOR DUI CONVICTION
FIRST OFFENSE DUI**

This cause came on for sentencing on conviction for DUI and the Court being satisfied it has complete jurisdiction, hereby FINDS and ORDERS:

1. The defendant is hereby convicted of a **first** offense DUI.
2. The defendant shall
 - (a) be fined \$_____ (*not less than \$250.00 nor more than \$1,000.00*) plus costs and assessments; and
 - (b) attend and complete an alcohol safety education program as provided in Section 63-11-32 within six (6) months of today's date.
3. In accordance with Miss. Code Ann. § 63-11-31(2)(b)(i), the defendant is hereby assessed, in addition to the criminal fines, penalties and assessments provided by law for violations of Section 63-11-30, a fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), to be deposited in the Interlock Device Fund in the State Treasury.
4. The defendant shall:

(Choose one)

 - be imprisoned in the county jail for _____ hours (*not more than forty-eight (48) hours*) with _____ hours suspended;
 - attend a victim impact panel.
5. The defendant shall be allowed to choose one of the following:
 - (a) have his/her driver's license suspended for one hundred twenty (120) days;
 - OR
 - (b) obtain an interlock-restricted license by:
 - (1) surrendering his/her driver's license to be voided; and
 - (2) obtaining a new driver's license that is restricted to operation of vehicles equipped with an ignition interlock device that complies with Section 63-11-31; and
 - (3) having an ignition-interlock device installed and operating on all motor vehicles owned or operated by the defendant; and
 - (4) not operating a vehicle that is not equipped with an ignition-interlock device; and
 - (5) not soliciting or having another person attempt to start or start a motor vehicle equipped with such a device.
6. Commercial driving privileges shall be suspended as provided in Section 63-1-216.
